The LSHTM invites applications for the Short Course on Planning for VISION 2020: The Right to Sight. This is a non-clinical course and is aimed at Ophthalmologists, Eye Health Programme Managers, and NGO staff working in developing countries.

The main aim of this course is to familiarise participants with the VISION 2020 initiative to eliminate avoidable blindness, and to equip participants with the knowledge in planning principles to establish community eye health programmes. This course will be taught by Community Eye Health experts using didactic teaching and small group work methods and will focus on planning eye care for population clusters of around one million in developing countries.

Participants in the course will receive a certificate of attendance.
