The MSc in Community Eye Health is designed to provide eye care professionals and planners with the knowledge and skills to reduce blindness and visual disability. Training in community eye health extends the training in clinical ophthalmology applied to individual patients, to a consideration of the eye health of whole populations – how these can be assessed, resourced and evaluated.

The course is designed in keeping with the aims, priorities and strategies of VISION 2020: the Right to Sight, which is a World Health Organisation initiative designed to eliminate avoidable and treatable blindness, globally. Applicants are expected to be health care professionals involved in eye care and have relevant work experience.

Course duration is one year (full-time) and the course is available on a part-time basis over two years.
